# JUSTICE REFLECTIONS ANNUAL REPORT 2010

The charity, Justice Reflections, has completed another successful year in terms of its continuing publications, but like many small concerns, is facing funding challenges.

Issues 21 completed the seventh series, and issues 22, 23 and 24 of the eighth series have been published, all containing essays from around the world relating justice to theological matters.

We continue to supply Third World prison ministry workers free of charge and, as in past years, this accounts for almost a third of our mailing list. With a budget around £8,000, rising printing and postage costs have depleted our reserves, and we need increased donations and more subscribers to help us balance our books. We are pursuing ways of recruiting more supporters in this coming year.

As always, the Trustees give grateful thanks to the help given by volunteers in Lincoln - Keith Jobling and Vivian Bowtell.
