JUSTICE REFLECTIONS ANNUAL REPORT 2012

The charity, Justice Reflections, has completed another successful year in terms of its continuing publications, but like many small concerns, is still facing funding challenges.

Issues 28, 29 and 30 completed the tenth series all containing six or seven essays from around the world relating justice to theological matters.

We continue to supply prison ministry workers in developing nations free of charge, and as in past years, this accounts for almost a third of our mailing list. With a budget around £7,000, rising printing and postage costs deplete our reserves, and we need increased donations and more subscribers to help us balance our books. We are pursuing ways of recruiting more supporters in this coming year, and we are also offering electronic format subscriptions.

During the year our Chairman and Treasurer attended the Prison Fellowship International Conference in Canada, and our Editor attended the Prison Fellowship UK Conference in Derbyshire. Both resulted in a few new subscriptions.

Our website www.justicereflections.org.uk helps us keep in touch with our supporters, and promotes our work.

As always, the Trustees give grateful thanks to the help given by volunteers in Lincoln - especially to Keith Jobling and also to Vivian Bowtell, our secretary, who has moved away from Lincoln and retired this year. We hope to have a replacement in the very near future

We hope to enjoy another year of sharing matters relating to restorative justice, theological insights, and pastoral and moral issues relating to all aspects of justice.
